GUIDELINE

The BSWQA follows the recommendations of the Global Initiative for Obstructive Lung Disease 2023 Report found at: 2023 GOLD Reports - Global Initiative for Chronic Obstructive Lung Disease - GOLD (goldcopd.org).

Summary of key changes include:

- 1. Vaccination Recommendations for people with COPD have been updated in line with current guidance from the CDC
- 2. The ABCD Assessment Tool has been revised to the ABE Assessment Tool to recognize the clinical relevance of exacerbations, independent of the level of symptoms
- 3. A table has been added with information on the Evidence Supporting a Reduction in Mortality with Pharmacotherapy and Non-pharmacotherapy in COPD Patients
- 4. The information and figures outlining Initial Pharmacological Treatment and Follow-up Pharmacological Treatment have been updated. In particular, the positioning of LABA+LAMA and of LABA+ICS has been changed
- 5. A new definition of COPD Exacerbation and a new set of parameters to assess exacerbation severity at the point of care has been included
